**STIPULATION OF THE PARTIES**

The Parties, through their undersigned counsel, hereby submit this Stipulation of the Parties and aver as follows:

*Background*

1. On December 20, 2019, Petitioners filed the underlying Petition for Review and an Application for Special Relief in the Form of an Emergency Preliminary Injunction.
2. After a hearing, on January 31, 2020, then-Judge Kevin Brobson issued a preliminary injunction, which enjoined then-Respondent Colonel Robert Evanchick, Commissioner of the Pennsylvania State Police (PSP),<sup>1</sup> and his

agents, servants and officers from “implementing or enforcing PSP’s new policy addressed to partially manufactured receivers as currently set forth in PSP’s letter of January 9, 2020, until final disposition of the Petition for Review, including appeals.” *See*, Order of January 31, 2020.

3. As the preliminary injunction protected Petitioners’ rights, with Respondent complying with the injunction and ceasing enforcement of the Policy, they took no further substantive action, until this Court issued its Rule to Show Cause on October 31, 2025.
4. As explained in Petitioners’ Answer of November 26, 2025, although the Parties did not believe an amicable resolution of this matter was possible at the time, they were able to agree upon a schedule for cross-summary relief applications.
5. On December 24, 2025, this Court granted Petitioners request and ordered the requested scheduling for cross-applications for summary relief and an associated briefing schedule. *See*, Order of December 24, 2025.
6. Since that time, the Parties have continued in their attempts to resolve this matter amicably and resultantly, believing resolution likely, requested that this Court stay the scheduling for the cross-applications for summary relief, which this Court granted. *See*, order of January 28, 2026.

7. This stipulation does not alter the Pennsylvania State Police's obligation to comply with any and all federal requirements as a point-of-contact state for NICS.

*Resolution of Litigation*

8. The complained of policy (as referenced in Paragraph 5 of the Petition for Review) in this matter is formally revoked by Acting Commissioner Bivens by way of this Stipulation.
9. Resultantly, the Parties agree to the following:
  - a. That the matter is now moot;
  - b. That the preliminary injunction issued from the Order of January 31, 2020 can be dissolved;
  - c. That the cost bond, in the amount of \$100.00, should be returned to counsel for the Petitioners;
  - d. That the Parties shall bear their own costs, expenses, and attorney fees in this matter;
  - e. That this matter can be marked discontinued without prejudice; and,
  - f. That an order, consistent with the above, be entered by this Court.

**WHEREFORE**, for the reason specified above, the Parties respectfully request that this Court approve this Stipulation of the Parties and enter an order consistent with the above stipulations.
